

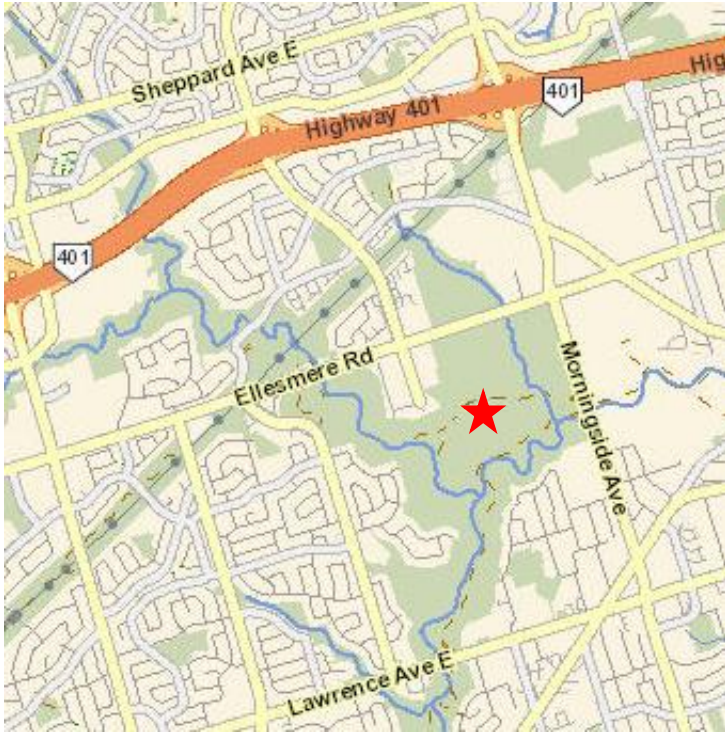
Morningside Park Planting Plan Spring 2017
