

Sylvan Park –Planting Plan Fall 2017

Park Location: Ward 43, South of Kingston Road off Sylvan Avenue.

Purpose: This planting is to replace dead and dying ash that were removed from this area in the winter of 2016 as a result of Emerald Ash Borer (EAB). The resultant plantings will also enhance the understory of the adjacent intact forest cover.
